Each Salona is meticulously built to exacting standards developed in conjunction with Germanischer Lloyds to meet stringent Category A: Ocean standards and exceed European CE construction standards.

Designed and built to deliver strong performance and reliance in all conditions, the new Salona 37 has a modern underbody and rig configuration so as to be easily driven in light air, yet can confidently be driven hard in the heavy stuff. Overall handling is made simple with well thought out deck plans which make excellent use of modern sail handling equipment from Harken as standard. The extensive quality and performance of the Salona 37, the excellence of the interior appointments and the overall fine characteristics and beauty of the Salona are sure to provide pride of ownership for years to come. The Salona 37 is the newest model for Salona, and has benefitted from several years of production experience by one of Europe's best up and coming new builders, and exemplifies the fine tuning and quality for which Salona is fast earning a reputation. The overall quality of the initial design and total execution of this boat is superb. If your'e considering a modern performance cruiser of any brand, you owe it to yourself to see, sail, and compare the value of the Salona before making any buying decision!

Accommodations

The interior configuration of this Salona 37 hull #8 is our standard interior layout with mahogany finish and features two private cabins with double berths, a popular 'keyhole' galley on the port side with a forward facing Nav. station to starboard and a large aft head aft to starboard. Optional configurations and interior finishes are available on new purchases.

Starting forward immediately aft of the forward watertight bulkhead is a is the master stateroom with large double V Berth with full length storage shelves above and outboard. Port and starboard side

offer assorted storage lockers and two hanging lockers with shelves outboard. Essentially the whole interior forward portion of the yacht is comprised of the master cabin. It is truly a proper stateroom; quite luxurious, spacious and private with plenty of natural light and ventilation with three opening overhead hatches with screens.

The main salon of this beautiful Salona 37 is comfortable and inviting with beautiful mahogany furniture throughout, well thought out lighting, and quality fixtures like positive locking latches on all lockers and drawers (throughout yacht), tasteful Kerrock (like Corian) countertops and attractive neutral tone 'like suede' upholstery. The 'keyhole' galley is to port and has great counter space, deep double SS sinks, a large top loading refrigerator and a gimballed two burner LPG stove w/ oven.

Opposing port and starboard full length settees (6'7") in the salon provide excellent sea berths and seating and with the double drop leaf salon table (removeable) it's easy to dine 4 adults. Custom storage lockers outboard above settees. The forward facing Nav. station is aft to stbd. of the salon and offers a large and proper chart table with chart light, assorted extra storage compartments and enough 'real estate' to properly mount an array of nav. and comm. equipment.

Immediately aft of the Nav. station conveniently located at the base of the companionway is the large head. The head is molded FRP with mahogany accents and Kerrock (like Corian) countertops and is quite large with opening ports for ventilation and large wet locker. Teak shower grate and manual shower sump pump.

A large quarter cabin with double berth is situated on the port side aft of the galley. As with the rest of the yacht, this cabin reflects the thoroughness and refinement of the design process and offers decent storage, excellent headroom and floor space, and good natural light and ventilation. This is the nicest quarter cabin we have seen on any yacht of this class.

All in all the interior of the Salona 37 is very pleasing, and much more than you might expect. The new Salona has been inspected by many industry professionals who are extremely knowledgeable and who can immediately distinguish between careful man hours and mass production. The Salona is quickly recognized as a quality yacht offering a sophisticated, luxury interior and well thought out living spaces and amenities.
